

Additional Kayak Launch Site Directions...



Directions to North Canaveral National Seashore:

Shipyard Island Canoe Trail/ Turtle Mound

To reach the North entrance of Canaveral National Seashore, take SR 44 east from I-95 or US 1 in New Smyrna Beach to A1A. Go approximately seven miles south on A1A to the boat ramp just north of the ranger station. There is a fee for entrance into the Seashore. There are restrooms at the boat ramp. Entrance to the canoe trail is across the channel from the boat ramp.

Directions to 1,000 Islands:

Directions: Launch from the end of Ramp Road in Cocoa Beach. From the intersection of SR 520 and Highway A1A, go south on A1A for several miles. Just past the Minuteman Causeway, turn right on 5th Avenue. Go one block west to North Brevard Avenue and turn left. Take the first right on Ramp Road and go to the park.

Directions to Turnbull Creek: 28°49'13.37N 80°51'35.31W

Launch from the northeast side of the US 1 Bridge over Turnbull Creek, located approximately 12 miles north of Mims. There is a dirt road that is difficult in wet weather on the north east side of the bridge that provides access and limited parking. If you go over a big overpass over a train track going north, you've gone too far, just barely. Pull off the road just past the bridge and pull back to the parking area just east of the bridge.

Directions to Lake Monroe Conservation Area: 28°47'10.60N 81°10'50.64W

Launch from Seminole County's Cameron Wight Park at SR 46 and the Lake Jessup Bridge. From I-95 and SR 46, go west on SR 46 for 21.1 miles. The park is on the northwest side of the bridge.

Directions to Turkey Creek/ Alex Goode Park: 28°01'46.94N 80°34'57.34W

Launch from Alex Goode Park in Port Malabar, FL

From the intersection of US 1 and US 192 in Melbourne, go south on US 1 for about 5.5 miles to Port Malabar Boulevard. Turn right and go over the railroad tracks to Bianca Drive. Turn right on Bianca Drive and follow it to the park.

Juniper Springs Run:

Launch from Juniper Springs Campground. Campground is located on the north side of SR40 just 3 miles west of SR19. SR 40 Connects Ocala @ I-75 and Ormond Beach @ I-95.
