

NORTH ENTRANCE DIRECTIONS TO HAULOVER CANAL LAUNCH SITE

From Titusville

From I-95:

Take I-95 North eleven miles to County Road 5A (exit 231). Follow 5A East 1 mile to US1/FL5. Take a left/North on US1/FL5 travel approximately 5 miles till you intersect SR3/Kennedy Parkway on your right. (Marked by the big brown sign for Merritt Island Wildlife Refuge) Turn right on Kennedy Parkway/South travel 8.5 miles till you see the Haulover Canal Drawbridge. Just before the bridge take a right. The road is unmarked. Follow that road along Haulover Canal to the very end. It will curve to the left and then to the right along the canal.

From US1/FL5:

US1/FL5 and Garden Street (SR406) Travel North on US1/FL5 travel approximately 17.5 miles till you intersect SR3/Kennedy Parkway on your right. (Marked by the big brown sign for Merritt Island Wildlife Refuge) Take Kennedy Parkway South 8.5 miles till you see the Haulover Canal Drawbridge. Just before the bridge take a right. The road is unmarked. Follow that road along Haulover Canal to the very end. That is where we will meet and launch the kayaks.

FROM UNIVERSAL, ORLANDO ATTRACTIONS:

Take the Beachline (SR528) East to I-95 North then follow the directions "From Titusville" above.

FROM CENTRAL ORLANDO:

Enter Titusville via SR50 and take I-95 North one exit to SR406/Garden St. (exit 220). Then follow the directions "From Titusville" above.

FROM MELBOURNE, COCOA BEACH, MERRITT ISLAND, PORT CANAVERAL AREA:

Enter Titusville from I-95 North (directions above) or US1/FL5 North to SR 406/402 Garden St. following the directions "From Titusville" above.

FROM JACKSONVILLE, DAYTONA, NEW SMYRNA, EDGWATER AREA:

1. Take I-95 South to County Road 5A (exit 231).

* Follow 5A East 1 mile to US1/FL5.

*Take a left/North on US1/FL5 travel approximately 5 miles till you intersect SR3/Kennedy Parkway on your right. (Marked by the big brown sign for Merritt Island Wildlife Refuge)

*Take Kennedy Parkway South 8.5 miles till you see the Haulover Canal Drawbridge. Just before the bridge take a right. The road is unmarked. *Follow that road along Haulover Canal to the very end. That is where we will meet and launch the kayaks.

Be sure to stop and use the restroom in town before coming out on the Refuge. Unfortunately, there are no facilities at the launch site.... Once you've arrived it is best to lock your valuables in the trunk or out of sight.
